

Amputation Specialty Program



2025 Outcomes

ADULT

- 49 patients were served, ages 29-80 (with an average age of 59 years).
- 80% of patients were White and 20% were Black.
- 49% were female and 51% were male.
- 3 patients were referred to our Return-To-Work program.
- Patients spent an average of 17.5 hours in physical therapy and 19.2 hours in occupational therapy
- 96% of long-term goals achieved
- 100% of patient surveyed live at home 90 days after their program.
- 100% of patients reached at 90-day follow-up used their prosthesis; 100% at 1-year follow-up.
- No patients had additional amputations at 90-day follow-up.
- No patients reported a foot ulcer at 90-day follow-up; one at 1-year follow-up.
- 2% of patients had an unplanned readmission to the hospital during their program (compared to the national average of 15%).
- 100% of patients surveyed returned to social activities and spending time with friends at 90-day follow-up; 100% at 1-year follow-up.
- 31% of patients reached for 90-day follow-up reported having fallen without injury. (goal is <25%). No patients reported having fallen with an injury.
- 100% of patients were better able to care for their daily needs at 90-day follow-up; 92% at one-year follow-up.
- 100% of patients reached make regular visits to their doctor at 90-day follow-up; 100% at one-year follow-up.
- 89% of patients reached for 90-day follow-up reported they are adjusting to life since their amputation; 100% at one-year follow-up.
- 18% of amputation patients dropped out of the program for various reasons. Goal is <15%.
- 100% surveyed were satisfied with the outcomes they achieved.

PEDIATRIC & ADOLESCENT

- 3 patients were served, ages 7-18 years (with an average age of 11 years).
- 33% of patients were female and 67% were male. 100% of patients were White.
- Patients on average had 3.9 hours of Physical Therapy and 5 hours of Occupational Therapy.
- 1 patient had an unplanned readmission to the hospital during their program (compared to the national average of 15%).
- 100% of patients surveyed at 90 days returned to activities and spending time with friends.
- 100% of patients surveyed have adjusted to life since their injury.
- 98% of long-term goals were achieved.
- 100% of those surveyed lived at home after their program.
- 100% of school-aged patients transitioned back to school.
